4. Entry fees

German teams: Single 50 €, Double/Pair 70 €, Quad/Four 100 €, Eight 120 €

Foreign teams: Single 40 €, Double/Pair 60 €; Quad/Four 90 €, Eight 110 €

Entry fees for entries after the entry deadline are doubled. The entry fees are due at the entry deadline on 24 April 2024, 6pm (CEST). Please submit the entry fees to the account indicated below and include the reference number issued by the online entry system. Otherwise the entry fees must be paid at least by 6pm (CEST) the day before the race in the regatta office in cash or debit or credit card. The surcharge for on-site payments is 10% of the entry fees (except late entries). Teams that have not paid their regatta fee on time are not eligible to start.

6. Additional regulations

a) For all races for age category B: The rules of racing (RWR) of the German Rowing Federation (DRV) apply. For all races age category A: The World Rowing rules of racing (RoR) apply – exception: For all lightweight races age category A the rules of racing (RWR) of the German Rowing Federation (DRV) apply for the weigh-in.

b) For races marked with a *, paragraph 2.5.11.5 RWR (German Rules of Racing) apply.

c) There will be no Team Managers' Meeting. The Team Information Center / regatta office is available to provide information.

d) For races 112, 113, 116, 117, 126, 127, 129 and 130 on Saturday and for races 240 to 243 on Sunday, there will be heats as well as finals B and A. The heats can be run with up to 7 starting places/lanes per heat. If there are more than 42 boats entered per race, the heats will be run as Time Trial.

e) All other races will be divided into qualifying divisions one evening before the start. The Saturday races are considered as qualification for the Sunday races. Sunday's heats will be set by the jury according to the placings 1-4 of Saturday. In the event of equal placings, time is considered. Only crews that started on Saturday with identical crews will be seeded for Sunday. The coxswains are an exception in the Quad/Fours and Eights. In addition, the rowing crew may be changed by 1 athlete in the Quad/Four and 2 athletes in the Eight.

f) In the event of withdrawals and/or crew changes, the jury reserves the right to carry out a new draw. In all other respects, the following regulations, some of which deviate from the RWR and/or the RoR, shall apply:

- Withdrawals, crew changes and late registrations should always be made no later than 4 pm of the preceding evening. Only then, they have the right to be considered for the draw. In addition, withdrawals, crew changes and late registrations are possible up to two hours before the start time of the first heat/division of their event.
- Crew changes: Qualified teams according to 6. e) lose their right to be seated in a certain heat/division due to crew change and may be transferred to the last heat/division. The substitutes can be from any club. For German crews in age group B, this only applies with simultaneous consideration of Clause 2.6.2 of the RWR.
- Late registrations are possible to fill heats/divisions. There is no right to late registrations.

g) German athletes must be registered in the DRV athletes' database and their physical fitness to row must be confirmed in order to start. If the athlete is registered in the DRV's active athlete database but does not yet have a medical certificate authorizing him/her to start, the medical certificate can also be submitted to the regatta office by 6 p.m. on the day before the regatta using the form provided by the DRV.

h) There are no rental boats available.

i) Catering: A catering service will provide lunch. Food for the teams should be ordered and paid in advance using our online entry system. There is a surcharge of 10% on site (availability not guaranteed).

j) Safety notes: On the whole venue, escape and emergency routes have to be kept free at all times. Marked restricted and all green areas must not be used to park vehicles. The paved area immediately in front of and behind the boathouses have to be kept clear during the entire event. Open fire and the preparation of food using electric, gas, or charcoal devices is prohibited. The preparation of food is only permitted in catering tents at the campground. Staying overnight in the boathouses (ground floor) and in the corridors of buildings A and B is forbidden in any case. In case of violations, an exclusion from the regatta may be considered.

k) Parking: From Friday at noon until the end of the event on Sunday, only drawing vehicles may enter the regatta venue to bring boat trailers in or pick them up. These drawing vehicles as well as all other vehicles have to park at the grandstand parking of the Olympic Regatta Course. The parking is subject to charges and is maintained by an external tenant. Parking passes are subject to a charge. All parking passes must be ordered in advance via our online entry system in order to ensure a smooth processing on site.

l) Claims arising from any damage to the event location or on the water cannot be asserted by the participants. The insurance of equipment and person is the responsibility of the participants. The organizer assumes no liability of any kind.

m) During the regatta, photos and videos will be taken. Participants who do not agree to this must object at the regatta office before the event.

n) In the event of cancellation due to force majeure (e.g. pandemic), the organizer accepts no liability for any costs incurred. The clubs are not entitled to claim reimbursement of the regatta fees or compensation for expenses from the organizer and its regatta committee. This also applies if the regatta or individual races are canceled/interrupted for compelling reasons.
