

Catering

The restaurant is located directly in the regatta building at the finish tower. Wilhelm Catering is looking forward to welcoming you. The opening hours of the restaurant will be announced at the regatta by posting in the service centre. Food will only be offered if ordered in advance. Snacks and drinks are available for visitors in front of the building.

Regatta regulations

The provisions of the official regatta information always apply with priority.

Crew changes, withdrawals, and late entries

You must submit crew changes, withdrawals and late entries online at max.m-start.de. You can use any web browser for this purpose. Alternatively, you will find terminals in the service centre where you can also make your entries. Please have the username and password of the original registrant ready. Notwithstanding the Rules of Racing and the German Rules of the Rowing Competition, the deadlines according to the official regatta information shall apply.

Results service

Our automated results service is available at the terminals in the service centre. There you can send the official results by e-mail. In addition, they are available on the internet at max.m-start.de

For sustainability reasons, we do not print out start lists or results for teams.

Weighing

All light weights are weighed according to the German rules and regulations (RWR) of the German Rowing Federation.

The scales are in the administration building behind the service centre. Please be sure to bring a photo ID for weighing. A test weighing is possible there on Friday from 14:00 to 20:00 hrs.

Team Managers Meeting

There will be no Team Managers Meeting. Please contact the service centre for more information.

Bow numbers

All boats must be provided with bow numbers. These will be issued at the service centre before the start for a deposit of 10 Euros and must be returned there after the race.

Racing attire

Please refer to paragraph 2.6.7 of the AWB / Rule 39 World Rowing Rules of Racing regarding racing attire.

Training times

Training at the track is possible as follows: Friday to Sunday from sunrise until 30 minutes before the first race and 30 minutes after the last race until sunset.

Start

A boat may not enter the start zone until it is clear for which race it has been assigned and the Starter has assigned a starting lane to the boat. The boats must be at their starting positions two minutes before the starting time. The instructions of the Starter and the jury in general must be followed. The Starter may start the race without regard to absentees and may caution a boat crew arriving late to their starting position.

Team tents

Tents, which serve the teams' stay, can be set up along the course in the designated areas free of charge after registration at the service centre. A corresponding area will be allocated by the regatta management, there is no entitlement to a special place. The preparation of meals is not permitted in these team tents.

Supply tents

A flat-rate fee will be charged for tents used to supply one's own team:

- In advance 50 €
- On site 60 €

Bookings are possible via the online entry system.

Boat storage

The storage of the boats is at the risk of the clubs. In case of possible damage, there is no legal claim against the organiser or the host.

Access to the venue

- **Towing vehicles** may drive onto the venue with trailers and park the boat trailers. They must then leave the venue within 30 minutes and can park in the grandstand parking area. For this they need a parking permit, which must be ordered in advance via the online entry system. Unloaded boat trailers are to be parked in the boat trailer parking area, not in the boat area.
- **Bus coaches** can drive onto the site and park on the left immediately after entering. They do not need a parking ticket for this. However, the space available for bus coaches is limited. Bus coaches must therefore be registered in advance at info@regatta.de.
- **Team/club vehicles** are not permitted to drive onto the venue but may park in the grandstand car park with direct access to the venue. There is a charge for the car park, which is maintained by an external leaseholder. Parking permits are chargeable (€14 for the entire event) and must be ordered in advance via our online entry system to ensure smooth processing on site.
- **Other visitors' vehicles** can park on site in the grandstand car park for €5/entry.

Parking permits

You can get pre-ordered parking permits for the grandstand car park at the container in front of the barrier on the right, directly after the exit from the B471, or at the service centre. For this purpose, you will receive a QR code by e-mail before the regatta, which you should bring with you on your mobile phone or printed out. This will speed up the process on site and avoid waiting times.

If you forget to order parking tickets in advance, you will have to park the vehicle outside the grounds and order a parking ticket at the service centre or online first.

Driving regulations on the premises

During the competition days, access to the boating area is strictly prohibited. Please park your trailers only in the specially designated parking spaces behind the boat halls and keep the access roads and all escape and rescue routes clear. Please understand that we will repeatedly ask you if you violate this regulation. We would also like to point out that in extreme cases we may exclude you from the event.

Walking, running, cycling and inline skating are prohibited on the grandstand-side waterfront road on competition days. Please inform your athletes! Coaches can accompany their rowers on the opposite shore road.

Grandstand

Unfortunately, the grandstand is closed for fire safety reasons. Spectators can watch the races in front of the grandstand and on the opposite side of the finish tower at the small open grandstand.

Covid-19-related measures

Currently there are no more federal Covid-19-related regulations and people are no longer required to wear face masks. Nevertheless, we ask all athletes, employees, and officials to act on their own responsibility and to observe the usual rules of conduct and hygiene.

Regatta proceedings and award ceremony

The course length for JF/JM A is 2000 metres, for JF/JM B 1500 metres.

Basically, six lanes are started at intervals of four minutes. This may be deviated from in the preliminary heats in accordance with the regatta information.

General procedure

For races 112 to 117, 126, 127, 129 and 130, heats will be held and later the finals C (for more than 15 entries), B and A. The same applies on Sunday for races 240 to 243. All other events will be divided into divisions eligible to win one hour before the start of the race. The Saturday races will be considered as qualification for the Sunday races. This means that the divisions on Sunday will be set by the jury according to the placings on Saturday. In the event of equal placings, time will be the deciding factor. Those who did not start on Saturday with the same crew will automatically be placed in the last race on Sunday.

Award ceremonies

Apart from the heats and the B and C finals, award ceremonies will take place after all races.

Junior B

The winners of each race will receive an original "Regatta München Winner" functional shirt as well as a medal. Only the first-placed athletes will be honoured at the winners' pontoon directly after their event. Due to the tight race schedule, the athletes will remain seated in their boats.

Junior A

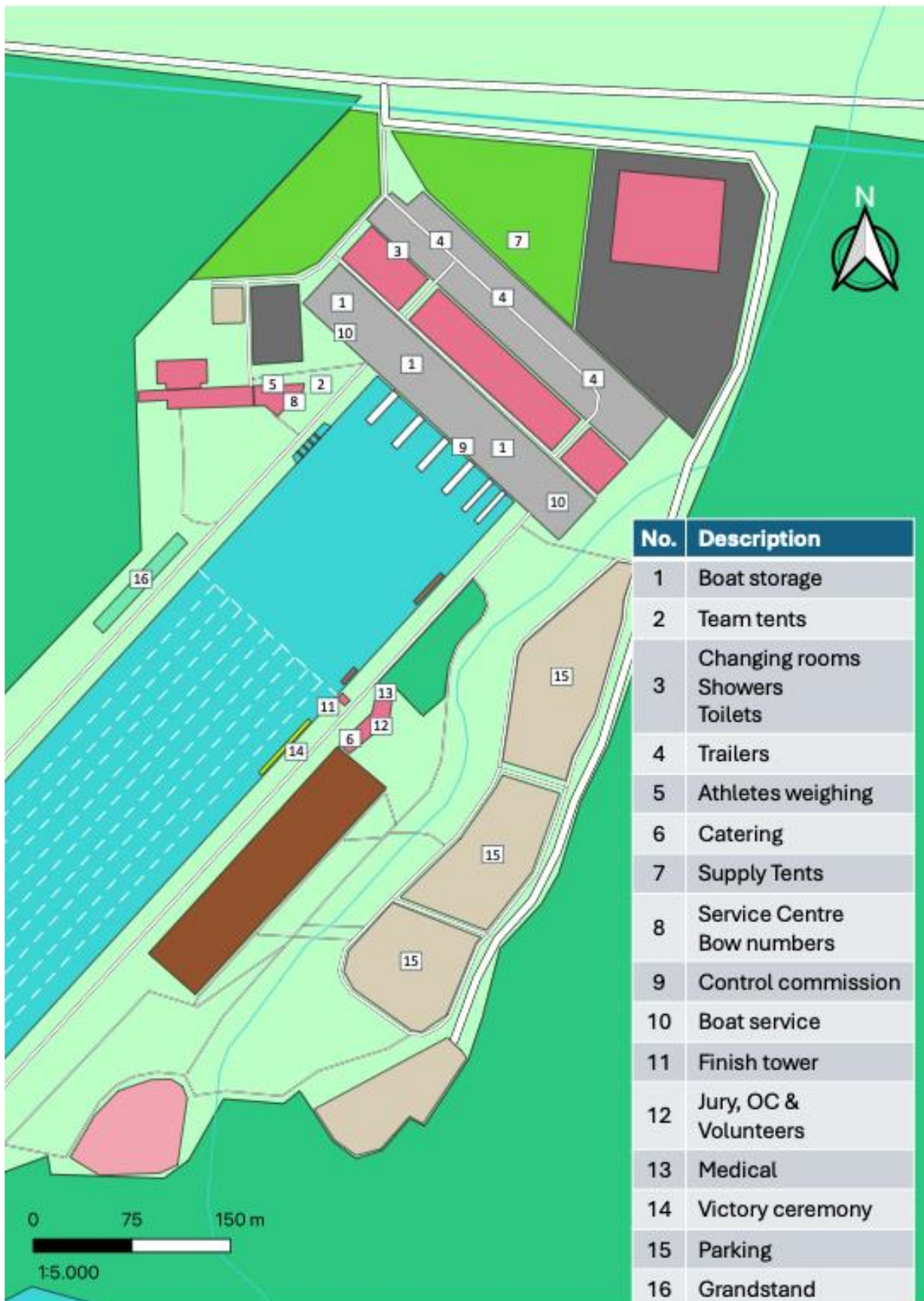
In races without heats, the winners will receive an original "Regatta München Winner" functional shirt and a medal. Only the first-placed athletes will be honoured directly after their race at the winners' pontoon. Due to the tight race schedule, the athletes will remain seated in their boats.

In races with heats, places 1 to 3 from the Final A races will receive their medals (gold, silver and bronze) on the winners' podium. The first-placed will also receive an original "Regatta München Winner" functional shirt.

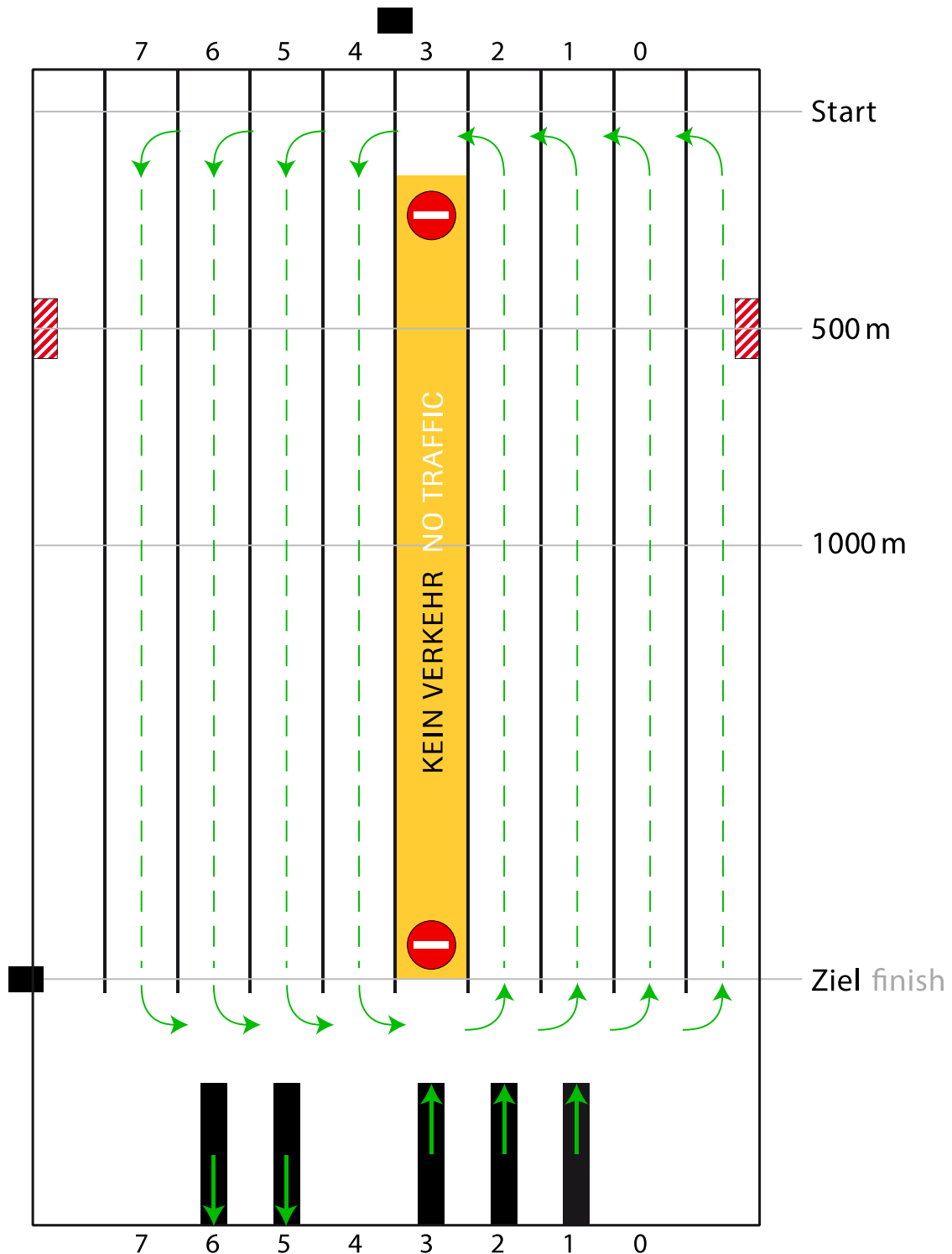
Site plan



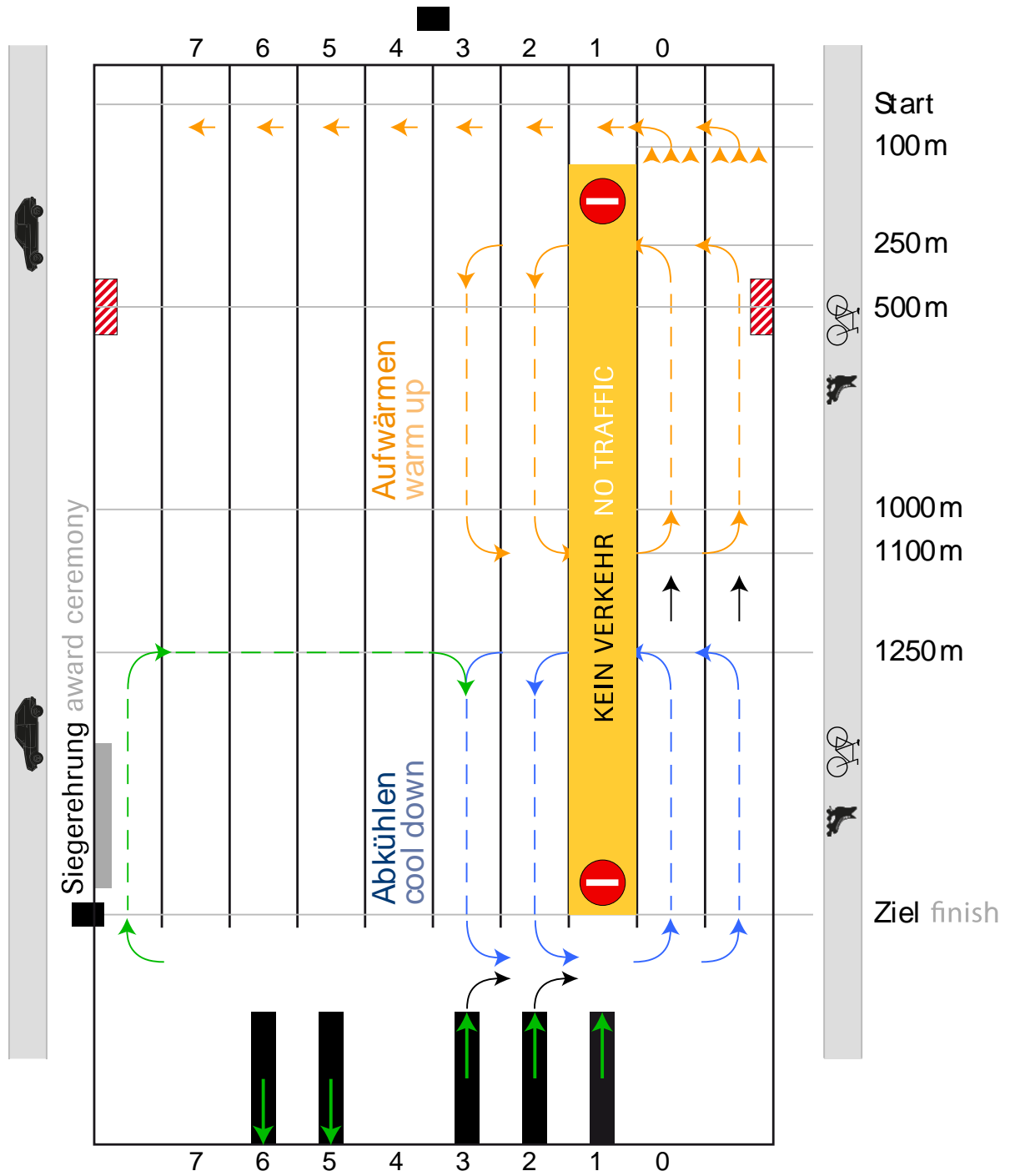
Traffic rules

The traffic rules must be observed at all times, whereby we refer to the notice boards at the boathouse area and ask you to observe the safety regulations in this programme booklet. Violations will be punished with warnings. The start zone and finish line must be kept clear of boats not involved in an event. For safety reasons, the warm-up for 1500 meter Junior B events is explicitly NOT permitted in lanes 4 to 7.

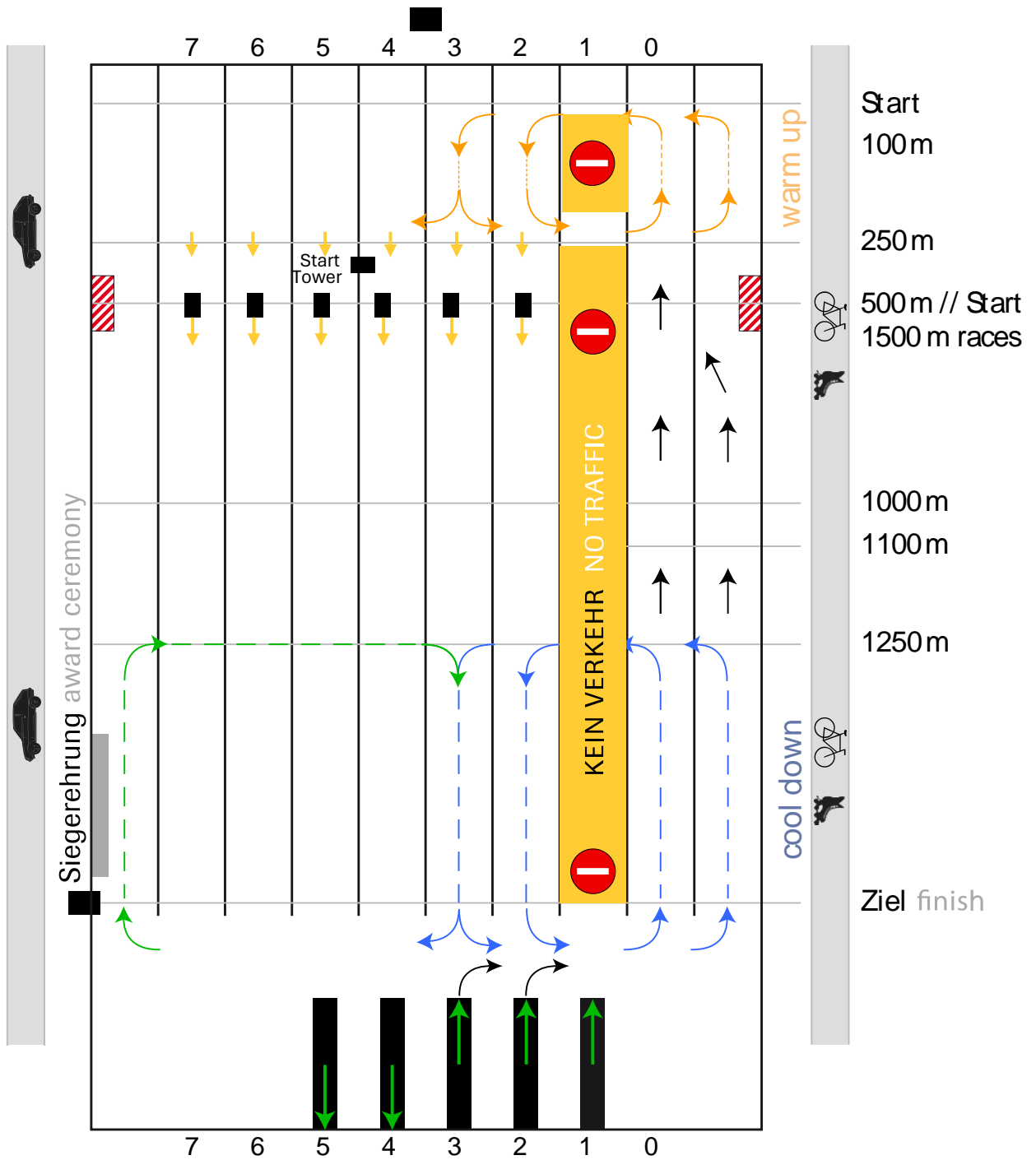
Traffic Rules – Training
